IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter fifty-three of the Private and Special Laws of 1903 in relation to fishing in Bagaduce River.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of Chapter fifty-three of the Private

- 2 and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three is hereby
- 3 amended by substituting in the last line of said section the
- 4 word December for the word February so that said section
- 5 as amended shall read as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to take or fish for eels in

- 7 any manner whatever in the Bagaduce river, Bagaduce bay
- 8 or any of the tributaries of said river or bay between the
- 9 fifteenth day of April and the first day of December of each 10 year.
