STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of Widow's Island.

Resolved: That there be and is hereby appropriated the
2 sum of seven thousand five hundred dollars for the use of
3 the Convalescent Insane Hospital at Widow's Island for the
4 year 1907 and two thousand five hundred dollars for the year
5 1908; said sum to be expended under the direction of the
6 Trustees of Insane Hospitals for the following purposes:

For the construction of an additional building, for a bath
8 and swimming pool, for a gasoline launch, for salary of care-
9 taker, for transportation of patients, officers and employees,
10 for additional bedding for repairs and cost of running
11 launch.

Commodious gasoline launch	1,500 00
Salary of person to care for the property of the state and pay for transportation of patients, officers and employees, including additional bedding and cost of running launch	5,000 00
