HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Lincoln County Street
Railway.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. All the rights, powers and privileges of the Lin-
coln County Street Railway which were granted by Chapter
twenty-three of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen
hundred and three are hereby extended to April first, nine-
teen hundred and nine.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
