STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT authorizing the Benvenue Granite Company to construct and maintain a railroad crossing or crossings in the town of Sullivan.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Benvenue Granite Company, a corporation 2 organized under the laws of New York State and having an 3 established place of business in Sullivan, in the county of 4 Hancock and state of Maine is hereby authorized and 5 empowered to construct and maintain a railroad crossing, or 6 crossings, at grade, over and across any highway in that part 7 of the town of Sullivan known as West Sullivan. Said 8 crossing or crossings to be built at such grade and under

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9 such conditions as may be prescribed by the railroad com-10 missioners of the State of Maine.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
