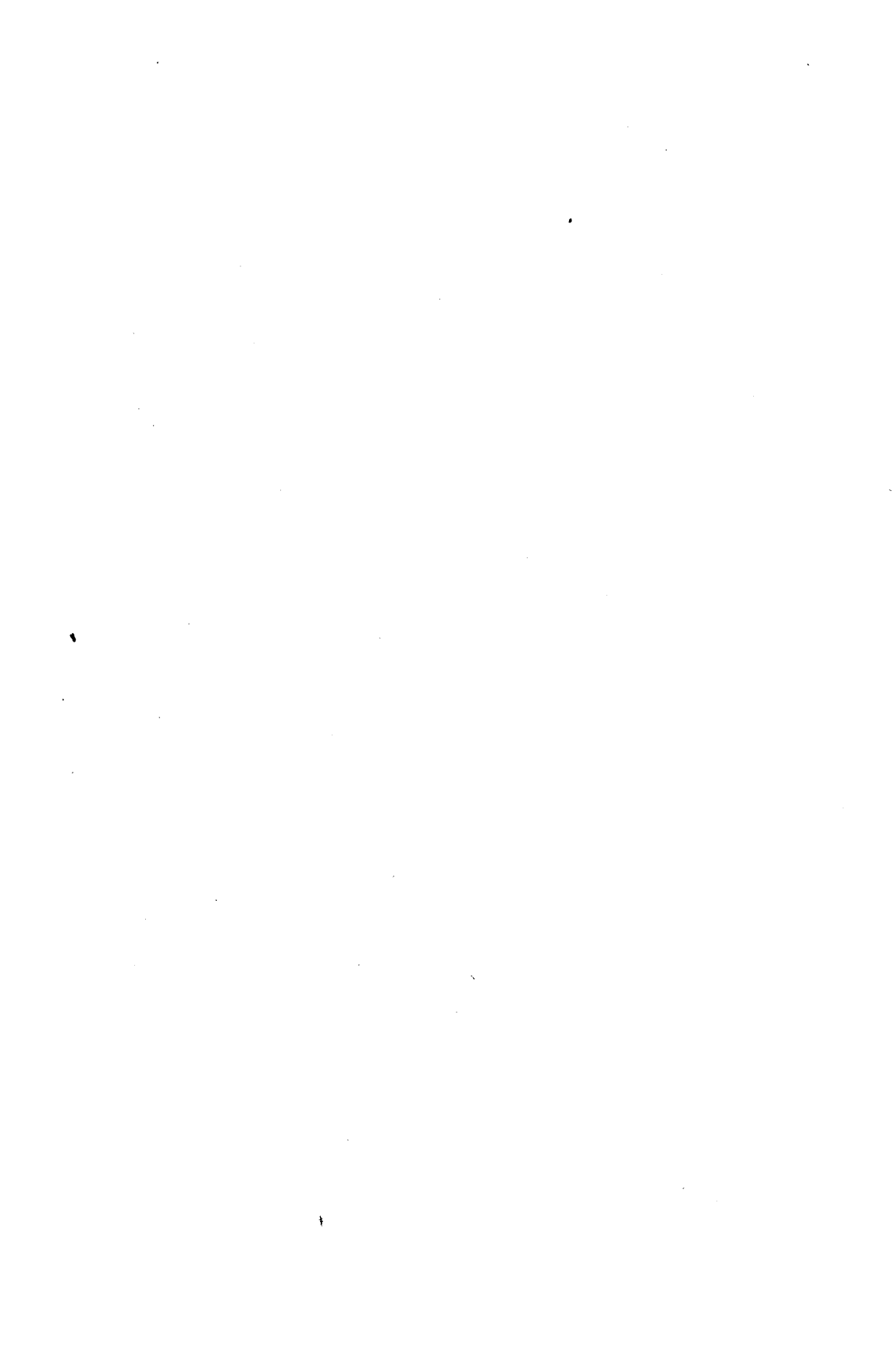
STATE OF MAINE

AN ACT to amend Section forty-four of Chapter ninety-one of
the Public Laws of 1905, relating to close time on smelts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section forty-four of Chapter ninety-one of the
2 Public Laws of 1905 is hereby amended by inserting after
3 the words "Passamaquoddy bay" in the thirty-fifth line the
4 words: 'and Cobscook bay and the coves and inlets tributary
5 to these bays' so that that part of said section as amended
6 shall read as follows: "nor to smelts taken in Passamaquoddy
7 Bay and Cobscook Bay and the coves and inlets tributary to
8 these bays between the first day of September and the first
9 day of October."
