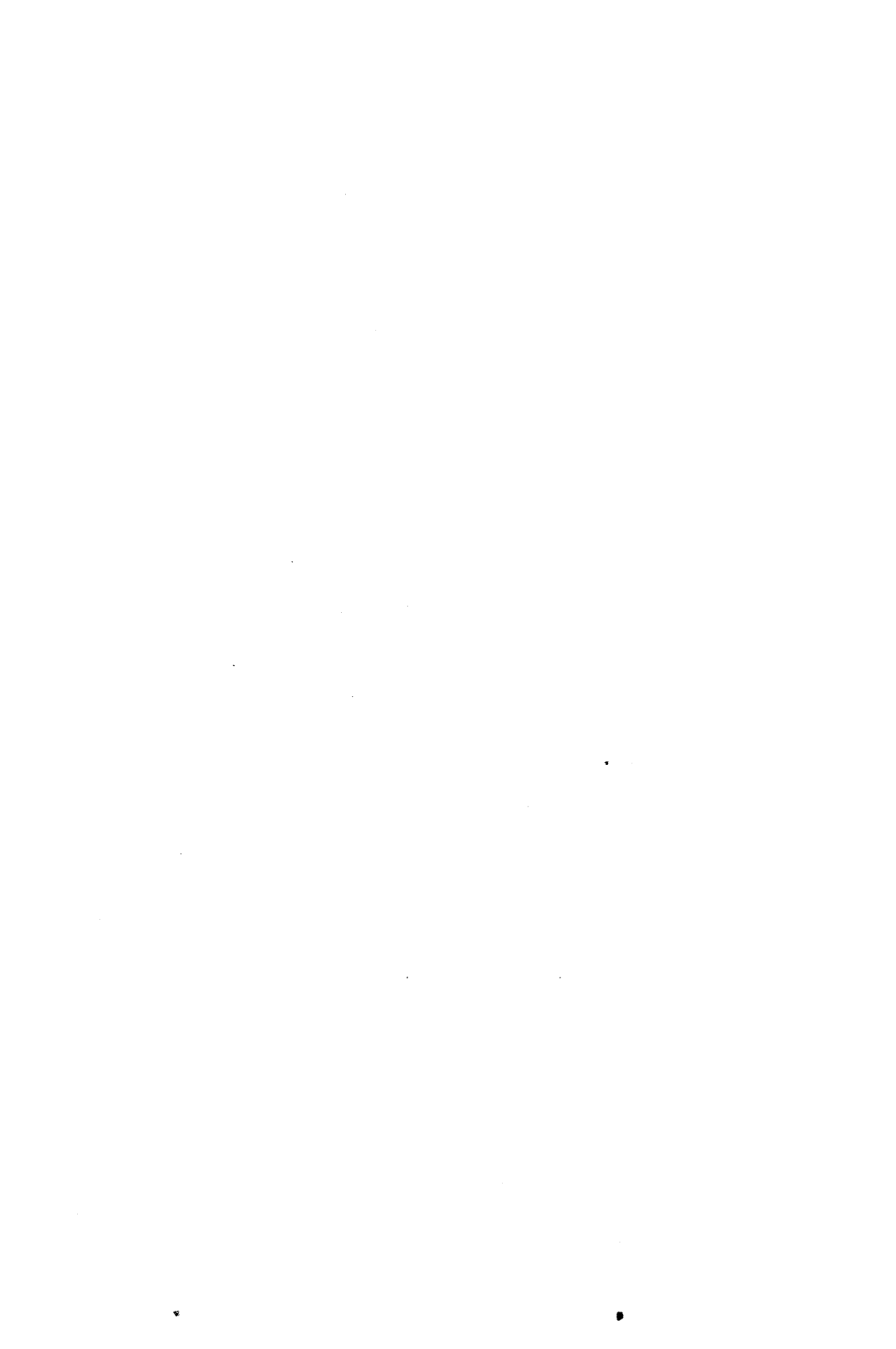

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated to the
2 Maine Industrial School for Girls two thousand five hun-
3 dred dollars for the year nineteen hundred seven for a resi-
4 dence for the steward; also a sum of one thousand dollars
5 to the said institution for the year nineteen hundred and
6 seven and one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hun-
7 dred and eight for the purposes of grading and laying out
8 the grounds, making a macadam driveway and setting out
9 suitable trees and shrubs.
