STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Big Lyford pond, in the
County of Piscataquis.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish at any time during the regular open
3 season in Big Lyford pond, in the county of Piscataquis,
4 except in the ordinary method of angling with artificial flies
5 or fly fishing.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars
3 nor more than thirty dollars and costs for each offense and
4 a further penalty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught,
5 killed or had in possession in violation hereof.

Sect. 3. Provided, further, that this act shall not take
2 effect until the Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and Game,
3 without expense to the State, have caused notices to be
4 posted in conspicuous places at or near the waters herein
5 described setting forth in substance the provisions of this
6 act.
