AN ACT to extend the charter of Sanford Trust Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Sanford Trust Company, which were granted by chapter 469 of the private and special laws of one thousand nine hundred and one, as amended by chapter 153 of the private and special laws of one thousand nine hundred and five, are hereby extended for two years from the approval of this act and the persons named in said act, their associates and successors, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them by said act, to be exercised in the same manner, and for the same purposes as specified in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
