STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Knox County General Hospital.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of fifteen hundred dollars to be paid to the Knox County
3 General Hospital for the general use of said institution for
4 the year nineteen hundred and seven, and fifteen hundred
5 dollars for the year nineteen hundred and eight; also the sum
6 of fifteen hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and
7 seven for the purpose of maintenance and repair of or addi-
8 tions to its buildings and grounds.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This hospital was incorporated by act of legislature 1903 to carry on the work previously done by the hospital while conducted as a general hospital by an association of physicians and surgeons. At this session \$1,500 per year for two years was appropriated. At the 1905 session \$1,500 per year for two years and \$1,000 additional for repairs and improvements was appropriated.

The institution has steadily increased its efficiency and the volume of relief given.
