IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

---

AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter one hundred sixty-six of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred eighty-seven, as amended by Chapter three hundred three of Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred five.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section one of Chapter one hundred sixty-six  
2 of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred  
3 eighty-seven, as amended by Chapter three hundred and  
4 three of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred  
5 and five, is hereby further amended by inserting in line two  
6 thereof, after the word "three" the words 'except so much of

7 said lot three as is now embraced in the farm of W. Holman  
8 Fisher,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The following described territory, namely:  
10 Lots numbered two, three, except so much of said lot three  
11 as is now embraced in the farm of W. Holman Fisher, eight,  
12 nine, ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen and sev-  
13 enty-nine, in the town of Fort Fairfield, according to Saw-  
14 yer's survey of Township Letter D in the first range, together  
15 with the inhabitants therein, be, and the same are hereby  
16 created a body politic and corporate by the name of the  
17 Fort Fairfield Village Corporation.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
