STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 267 of the Private and Special Laws of 1905 in relation to Alfred Light and Power Company, and to legalize its issue of bonds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The trust deed of Alfred Light and Power
- 2 Company to Knickerbocker Trust Company dated July first,
- 3 in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and five,
- 4 and the issue of bonds secured thereby is hereby ratified,
- 5 confirmed and made valid.
- Sect. 2. Section two of said act is hereby amended by
- 2 striking out the whole of said section and substituting the
- 3 following:

'Sect. 2. The purposes of said corporation are the making, 5 generating, selling, distributing and supplying electricity, 6 for manufacturing, mechanical, power and light purposes 7 to Sanford Mills, Goodall Worsted Company, Maine Alpaca 8 Company and Atlantic Shore Line Railway, corporations 9 existing under the laws of the State of Maine and located 10 in Sanford, York county, Maine, with all the rights, privilleges and powers, and subject to all the restrictions and 12 liabilities by law incident to corporations of a similar nature.'

Sect. 3. Section five of said act is hereby repealed.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
