IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Mutual Fire Insurance
Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Mutual
2 Fire Insurance Company which were granted by chapter five
3 hundred and thirty-four of the private and special laws for
4 the year eighteen hundred and ninety-seven and extended by
5 chapter seventy-one of the private and special laws of
6 eighteen hundred and ninety-nine and again extended by
7 chapter two hundred and ninety of the private and special
8 laws of nineteen hundred and one, and again extended by
9 chapter ninety-two of the private and special laws of nine-
10 teen hundred and three, and again extended by chapter three

11 hundred and nineteen of the private and special laws of nine-
12 teen hundred and five are hereby further extended for two
13 years from the approval of this act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
