## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to make valid the incorporation and corporate acts of Fort Fairfield Grange.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The incorporation of Fort Fairfield Grange,
- 2 as effected in October, 1884, under the provisions of chapter
- 3 55 of the Revised Statutes, edition of 1883, is hereby legal-
- 4 ized and made valid.
  - Sect. 2. The acts and doings, as a corporation, of Fort
- 2 Fairfield Grange, from October first, 1884, up to the date
- 3 of the passage of this act, are hereby legalized and made
- 4 valid.
  - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
