IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT relating to coroners' inquests in case of fatal accidents on railroads.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The provisions of section 69 of chapter 52 of
- 2 the Revised Statutes shall apply to all coroners' inquests
- 3 held in cases where any person shall be fatally injured on
- 4 any steam railroad or street railroad in this state, and the
- 5 coroner in such cases shall have all the powers of the board
- 6 of railroad commissioners as specified in said section 69.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
