STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to preserve the purity of the source of water supply for the village of Buckfield and to protect the public health.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. No structure, cesspool, privy or outhouse shall
2 hereafter be erected or maintained within the distance of two
3 hundred feet of the waters of North Pond, so called, in the
4 towns of Sumner and Buckfield in the county of Oxford,
5 the source of the water supply for the village of Buckfield.
Sect. 2. No sewage, drainage, refuse or polluting matter

2 of such kind and amount, as either by itself or in connection
3 with other matter, will corrupt or impair the quality of the
4 water of said North Pond or render it injurious to health,

5 shall be discharged into said pond, or put upon the ice 6 thereon, but nothing herein shall prohibit the cultivation and 7 use of the soil in the ordinary methods of agriculture if no 8 human excrement is used thereon within three hundred feet 9 of said pond.

Sect. 3. The supreme judicial court shall have jurisdic-2 tion in equity to enjoin, prevent or restrain any violation 3 of the provisions of this act.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
