IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Jackman Water Company.

Bc it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Jack-2 man Water Company which were granted by chapter two 3 hundred and thirty-six of the Special Laws of one thousand 4 nine hundred and five, are hereby extended for two years 5 from the approval of this act and the persons named in said 6 act, their associates and successors shall have all the rights, 7 powers and privileges that were granted them by said act to 8 be exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes 9 as specified in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
