### STATE OF MAINE.

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT authorizing the Umbagog Paper Company to locate, erect and maintain piers and booms in the Kennebec River.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Umbagog Paper Company, its successors 2 and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to locate, 3 erect and maintain in the Kennebec river, between Caratunk 4 Falls in the towns of Embden and Solon and the "Ellis" farm, 5 so called, in the town of Concord, piers and booms for the 6 purpose of collecting, holding and sorting logs, pulp wood 7 and other lumber coming down said Kennebec river. Said 8 works shall be so constructed as to provide for the prompt

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9 and convenient passage of all logs, pulp wood and other lum-10 ber that may come within the same, without unreasonable II or unnecessary delay; and it shall be the duty of said Umba-12 gog Paper Company to sort and turn out at least thirty 13 thousand logs per day on the average, each week, through 14 said booms, when there is that number therein; but in 15 case said Umbagog Paper Company does not sort and turn 16 out the required number, the Kennebec Log Driving Com-17 pany, upon notice to said Umbagog Paper Company in writ-18 ing, left at its office, shall have the right to put men of its 19 own selection upon said booms at the charge and expense of 20 said Umbagog Paper Company, in order that the required 21 number of logs may be put through the same; but nothing 22 herein contained shall make said Umbagog Paper Company 23 liable for any delay caused by said piers and booms except 24 as herein otherwise specified. Any stray logs, pulp wood or 25 other lumber not destined for use and manufacture at the 26 mills of said Umbagog Paper Company, if found in the stor-27 age booms of said Umbagog Paper Company, shall be turned 28 out thereof by said Umbagog Paper Company, at its own 29 charge and expense, upon demand in writing of the owners 30 thereof, or of said Kennebec Log Driving Company. All 31 damages for flowage caused by the construction of said piers 32 and booms shall be determined by the county commissioners 33 of Somerset county.

Section 2. Said Umbagog Paper Company shall be liable 2 to indemnify the Kennebec Log Driving Company and the

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3 log owners for any loss or damage by reason of logs or other
4 lumber lodged on lands adjoining the waters affected by any
5 works constructed under this act whenever said lodgment
6 is caused by any jam produced by said works.

Sect. 3. Said Umbagog Paper Company, its successors 2 and assigns, may take such lands as may be necessary for 3 the erection and maintenance of said piers and booms men-4 tioned in Section one and connect the same with the shores, 5 and may with their agents and teams pass and repass over 6 said shores to and from the same over the lands of other 7 persons, for the purposes aforesaid and for the operation 8 and management of said booms. Said company shall be held 9 liable to pay all damages that shall be sustained by any per-10 son or persons by the taking of any lands or rights of way II and for any other injuries resulting from said acts; and if 12 any person sustaining damage as aforesaid, shall not agree 13 with said company upon the sum to be paid therefor, either 14 party on petition to the county commissioners of Somerset 15 county, may have damages assessed by them; and subsequent 16 proceedings and rights of appeal thereon shall be had in the 17 same manner and under the same conditions, restrictions and 18 limitations as are by law prescribed in the case of damages 19 by the laying out of highways.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
