Resolved, That the sum of one thousand dollars be and is
2 hereby appropriated to repair roads and bridges in the
3 Indian township, Washington county, for the year nineteen
4 hundred and seven and one thousand dollars for the year
5 nineteen hundred and eight. Said appropriations to be
6 expended under the direction of the governor and council.
