## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE authorizing the Land Agent to release the interest of the state in the islets called "The Nub" in Bluehill in Hancock county.

Resolved, That the state land agent be, and he is hereby 2 authorized and empowered upon payment of the nominal 3 consideration of five dollars to make, execute and deliver a 4 good and sufficient deed releasing to Albert R. Conary of 5 Bluehill, Hancock county, Maine, and his heirs and assigns, 6 all the right, title and interest, which the state of Maine has 7 in and to two wooded islands, so called, which lie nearest 8 and immediately adjacent to the tract of land at Bluehill 9 Falls in Hancock county called Mill Point; said islands, or 10 one or more of them, being designated on the official map of 11 the United States Geological Survey as "The Nub;" together 12 with their adjacent and connected and outlying rocks and 13 reefs to the line of lowest tide on all sides of the same.
