RESOLVE in favor of Maine Children's Home Society,
Augusta.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum
2 of eight hundred dollars for the use of the Maine Children's
3 Home Society for the year nineteen hundred and seven and
4 eight hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and
5 eight, both said sums for the current expenses of said
6 society; also the further sum of four hundred and fifty
7 dollars for the year nineteen hundred and seven and four
8 hundred and fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred and
9 eight, both said sums for improvements and repairs.
