IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to incorporate the town of Bowerbank.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Township numbered seven (7) in the eighth
2 (8) range north of the Waldo Patent, together with a tract
3 of land northerly of Sebec Pond which was set off from the
4 town of Foxcroft and annexed to said township number
5 seven, in the eighth range by an act passed February twenty-
6 third, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-eight; being
7 what was once the town of Bowerbank in the county of Pis-
8 cataquis, with the inhabitants thereof, be and the same
9 hereby is incorporated into a town by the name of Bower-
10 bank, vested with all the powers and subject to all the duties
11 of other incorporated towns in this state, and with all the

12 rights and duties that the former town of Bowerbank had
13 before the charter was repealed by Chapter seventy-four,
14 Private and Special Laws of one thousand eight hundred
15 and sixty-nine.

Sect. 2. Said town shall be organized by compliance with
2 the provisions of the Revised Statutes in relation to the
3 organization of towns.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
