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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

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AN ACT to amend Section fifty-one of Chapter seventy-nine  
of the Revised Statutes relating to the holding of courts in  
Aroostook County.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section fifty-one of chapter seventy-nine of the  
2 Revised Statutes, so far as it relates to the holding of trial  
3 courts in Aroostook county is hereby amended so as to read  
4 as follows:

“Aroostook, at Houlton, on the first Tuesday of April, and  
6 the third Tuesday of September for civil and criminal busi-  
7 ness, and at Caribou on the third Tuesday of November for  
8 civil business only. At every April term the court shall  
9 adjourn to reconvene at Caribou the third Tuesday of April

10 for the trial of such causes as may be more conveniently  
11 there tried and heard, and the jurors in attendance at said  
12 court, except grand jurors, may be required to attend such  
13 adjournment or may be discharged and new jurors sum-  
14 moned, as the circumstances may require.”

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
