STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section fifty-one of Chapter seventy-nine of the Revised Statutes, relating to the holding of trial courts in Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. Section fifty-one of chapter seventy-nine of 2 the Revised Statutes, so far as it relates to the holding of 3 trial courts in Aroostook county, is hereby amended so as 4 to read as follows:

"Aroostook, at Houlton, on the third Tuesday of Septem-6 ber for civil and criminal business, and at Caribou on the 7 first Tuesday of April and on the third Tuesday of Novem-8 ber for civil business only. And at every April term the 9 court, upon the completion of the business conveniently 10 triable therein at said Caribou, shall adjourn to Houlton 11 and there complete such civil business as is most conveniently triable there; and shall also hold a criminal term for 13 the trial of criminal causes; and the jurors in attendance 14 at said court, except grand jurors, may be required to attend 15 such adjournment, or may be discharged or new jurors 16 summoned as the circumstances may require."

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
