IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to incorporate the Augusta Mutual Plate Glass Insurance Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. George E. Macomber, Charles R. Witten, 2 Frank E. Smith, Edwin C. Dudley, Guy P. Gannett, Charles 3 B. Paine, Royal H. Bodwell, Charles H. Howard, Lester B. 4 Howard and Eugene C. Carll are hereby made a corporation 5 under the name of the Augusta Mutual Plate Glass Insur-6 and Company, for the purpose only of carrying on business 7 as a mutual insurance company for insuring against break-8 age or damage to plate glass, local or in transit, with all 9 the powers, rights and privileges and subject to all the 10 duties, liabilities and restrictions set forth in all the general

11 laws of the state relating to such insurance corporations, 12 except as herein provided.

Sect. 2. No policy shall be issued by said company unti 2 fifty (50) applications have been made in good faith.

Sect. 3. The agents of said company shall be licensed 2 in the same manner as agents of mutual fire insurance com-3 panies.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
