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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE, in favor of Barrett Potter.

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*Resolved,* That the sum of four hundred and twenty-  
2 nine dollars and forty-two cents be and is hereby appropria-  
3 ted, to be paid to Barrett Potter, of Brunswick, chairman  
4 of the special committee on the University of Maine, to  
5 re-imburse him for the actual cash expenses of said commit-  
6 tee, and of each member thereof, incurred in the discharge  
7 of their official duties, the same having been paid by the  
8 said Potter.
