IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter one hundred sixty-one of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred five, relating to the taking of clams in Yarmouth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter one hundred sixty-one of the Public Laws of the 2 year nineteen hundred five, relating to the taking of clams, 3 shall apply to the town of Yarmouth in Cumberland county, 4 and said town of Yarmouth may fix the times in which 5 clams may be taken within its limits in the manner and sub-6 ject to the provisons of this chapter notwithstanding any 7 limitations contained in its charter.
