STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend sections thirteen and one hundred and twenty-four of Chapter fifteen of the Revised Statutes, relating to the mill fund and school tax.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section thirteen of chapter fifteen of the Revised
- 2 Statutes is hereby amended by striking out in the fifth line
- 3 thereof the word "eighty" and inserting in its stead the word
- 4 'thirty,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:
 - 'Sect. 13. Every town shall raise and expend, annually,
- 6 for the support of common schools therein, exclusive of the
- 7 income of any corporate school fund, or of any grant from
- 8 the revenue or fund from the State, or of any voluntary

9 donation, devise or bequest, or of any forfeiture accruing 10 to the use of schools, not less than thirty cents for each 11 inhabitant, according to the census by which representatives 12 to the legislature were last apportioned, under penalty of 13 forfeiting not less than twice nor more than four times the 14 amount of its deficiency, and all moneys provided by towns, 15 or apportioned by the State for the support of common 16 schools, shall be expended for the maintenance of common 17 schools established and controlled by the towns by which 18 said moneys are provided, or to which said moneys are 19 apportioned.'

Sect. 2. Section one hundred and twenty-four of chapter 2 fifteen of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking 3 out the words "one mill" in the first line thereof and inserting 4 in their place the words 'two mills,' so that said section as 5 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 124. A tax of two mills on a dollar shall annually 7 be assessed upon all the property in the State according to 8 the valuation thereof, and shall be known as the mill tax 9 for the support of common schools.'

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
