AN ACT relating to the extension of the Fryeburg Horse
Railroad.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Fryeburg Horse Railroad Company is
2 hereby authorized and empowered to extend its road from
3 any point or place where now constructed, or to be con-
4 structed, in Fryeburg, to any points or places in the town
5 of Brownfield, Hiram and Porter, in Oxford county, and
6 the town of Cornish, in York county, as it may find con-
7 venient, either on streets, roads or ways, or on private prop-
8 erty or partly on one and partly on the other, as may be
9 approved by the railroad commissioners, and said company

10 shall have all the powers given by sections seven and twelve
11 of chapter fifty-three of the Revised Statutes to appropriate
12 property for the purposes of this section. Nothing in this
13 section shall be construed to deprive the municipal officers
14 of the towns, wherein such extensions shall be built, of any
15 of their powers under said chapter fifty-three.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
