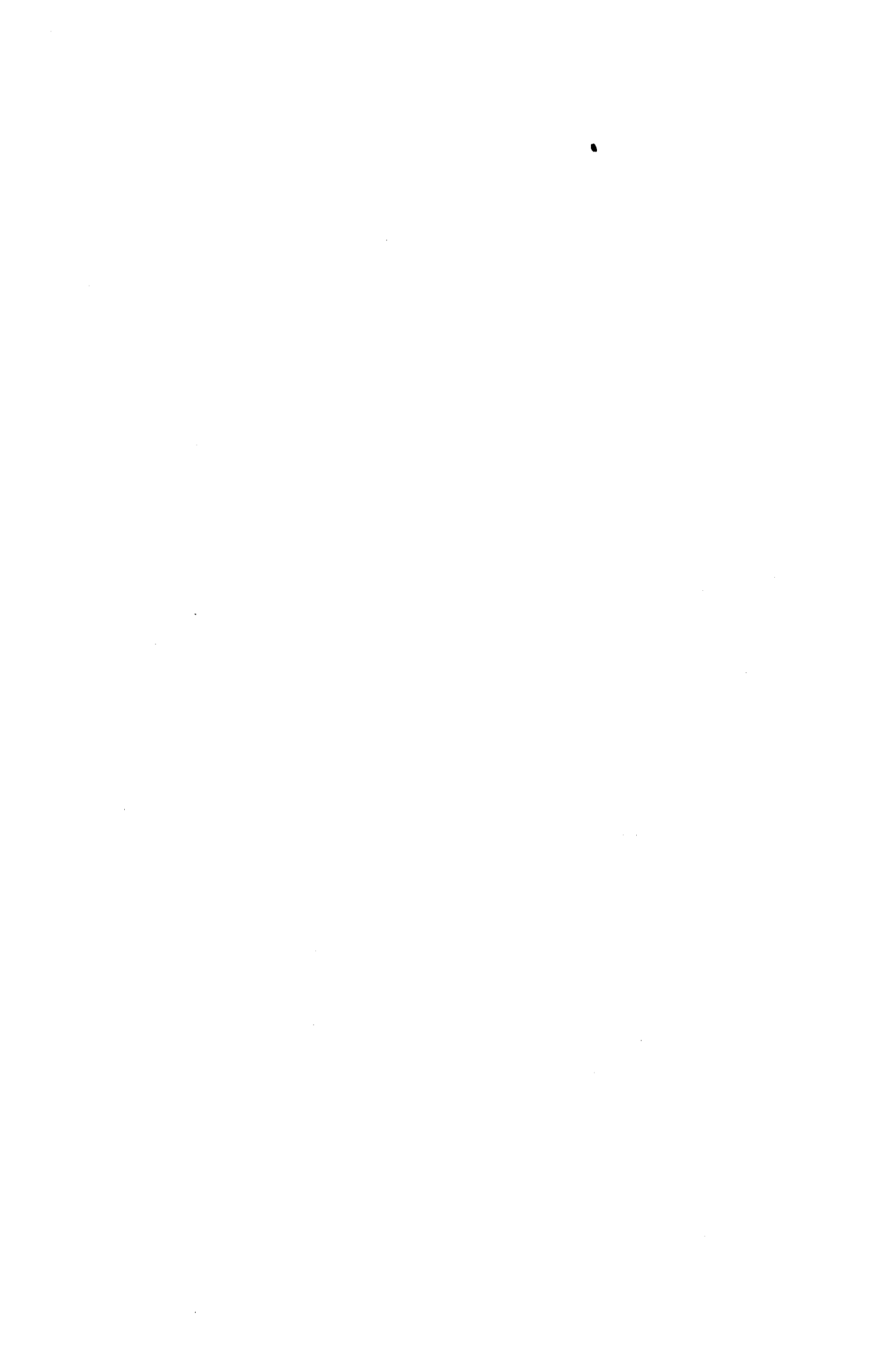
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT additional to and amendatory of chapter four hundred
and seven of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hun-
dred and three, relating to ice fishing in Allen Pond in the
town of Greene.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be lawful to fish through the ice for
2 pickerel in Allen pond in the town of Greene, on Tuesdays
3 and Thursdays of each week during the winter season.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
