IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to prohibit ice fishing in China Lake, in China and
Vassalboro, and in Lovejoy Pond, in Albion, in the County
of Kennebec.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish through the ice in China lake, so called,
3 in China and Vassalboro, in the county of Kennebec, or in
4 Lovejoy pond, so called, in Albion, in said county of Ken-
5 nebec.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided for
3 illegal fishing in section 1 of chapter 32 of the Revised Stat-
4 utes, as amended by chapter 132 of the Public Laws of 1905.
