STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter five hundred thirtyeight of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, relating to the taking of smelts in Sheepscot River.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature asembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter five hundred thirty-eight 2 of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and 3 eighty-nine is hereby amended by striking out from said 4 section the words "Wiscasset toll bridge" and inserting the 5 following in place thereof:

'A line from Thrope Island in Boothbay in a southwesterly 7 direction to Low Point in Georgetown on a line drawn across 8 all tide waters from shore to shore from Thrope Island to

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9 Low Point and all coves on said line between said paints,' 10 so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

Section I. No person shall fish for smelts in the Sheep-12 scot river, or its tributaries between a line from Thorpe 13 Island in Boothbay, in a southwesterly direction to Low 14 Point in Georgetown, on a line drawn across all tide waters 15 from shore to shore from Thorpe Island to Low Point and 16 all coves on said line between said points and head of tide 17 in Alna, except by hook and line.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
