IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Round and Long Ponds and  
their tributaries in Livermore.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or  
2 kill any kind of fish through the ice in Round or Long ponds,  
3 in the town of Livermore, county of Androscoggin, for a  
4 period of six years.

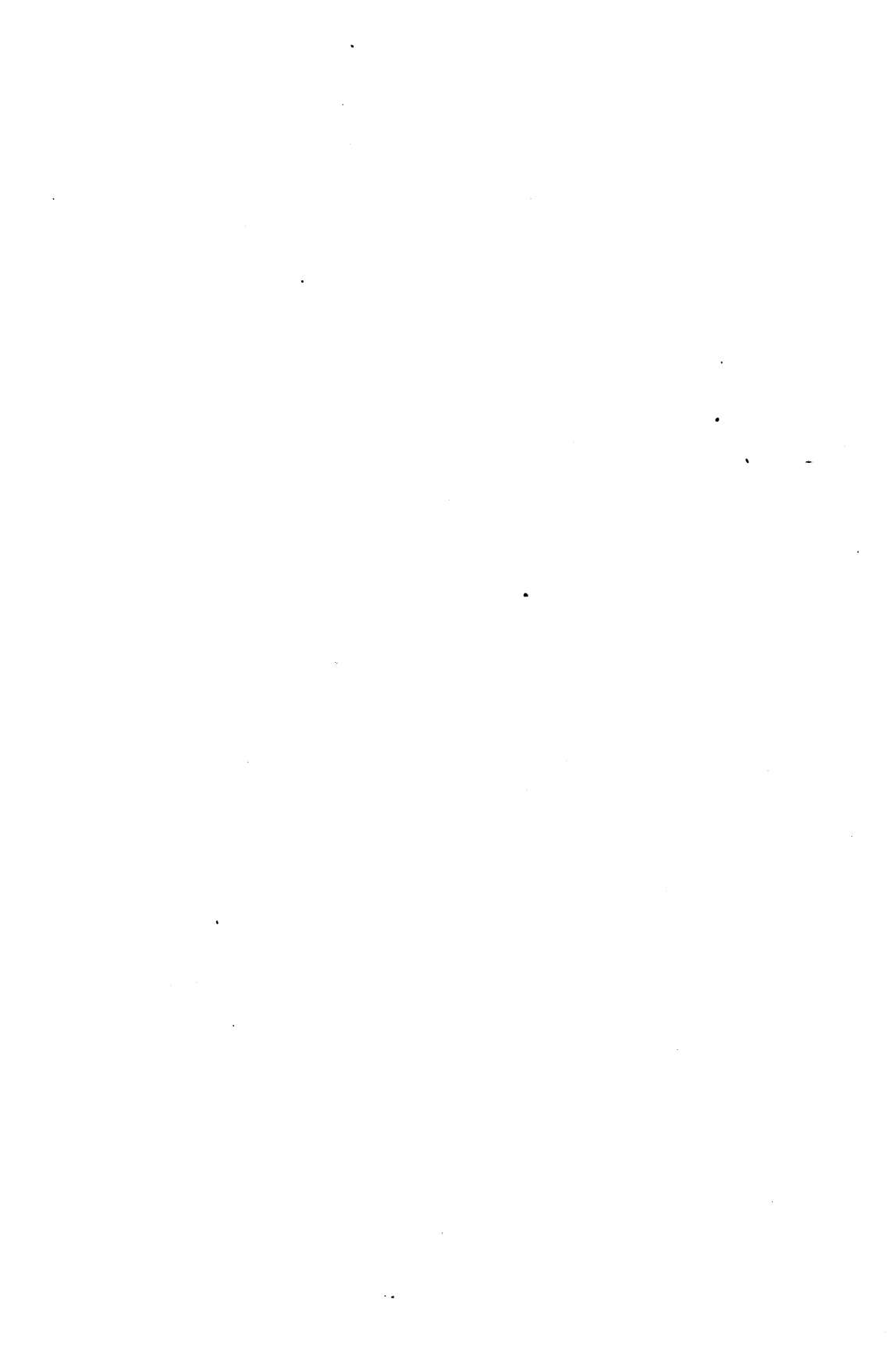
Sect. 2. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or kill  
2 any kind of fish at any time in any of the tributaries of said  
3 Round or Long ponds, which ponds are situated in the town  
4 of Livermore, county of Androscoggin.

Sect. 3. It shall be unlawful to take, catch, kill or have in  
2 possession any trout less than eight inches in length or any

3 landlocked salmon less than twelve inches in length taken  
4 from either of these ponds.

Sect. 4. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this  
2 act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than ten nor more  
3 than thirty dollars for each offense and a further penalty  
4 of one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or had in  
5 possession in violation of the provisions of this act.

Sect. 5. Provided, further, that this act shall not take  
2 effect until the Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and Game,  
3 without expense to the State, have caused notices to be  
4 posted in conspicuous places at or near the waters herein  
5 described setting forth in substance the provisions of this act.
