AN ACT to permit ice fishing for pickerel in Bear pond in the town of Turner, in the County of Androscoggin, and in the town of Hartford, in the County of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

So much of Section 1 of Chapter 407 of the Private and 2 Special Laws of 1903 as prohibits fishing through the ice for 3 pickerel in Bear pond, in the town of Hartford in the county 4 of Oxford, and in the town of Turner, in the county of 5 Androscoggin, is hereby repealed.
