## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Little Big Wood Pond, also  
Wood Stream, in Somerset County, also to regulate the taking  
of cusk in all the Moose River waters.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be lawful for citizens of the State to  
2 fish through the ice in Little Big Wood pond, in Somerset  
3 county, for trout and togue, during February, March and  
4 April of each year, as provided in the general law of the  
5 State.

Sect. 2. It shall be lawful to fish in Wood stream, in the  
2 county of Somerset, for trout as provided in the general  
3 law of the State.

Sect. 3. It shall be lawful to fish for cusk during the night  
2 time in all the Moose river waters in the county of Somerset,
