IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in East Carry Pond in the County  
of Somerset.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to take,  
2 catch or kill with bait and hook more than twenty-five trout  
3 in one day in East Carry pond, in the county of Somerset;  
4 it shall also be unlawful for any person to take, catch or kill  
5 with artificial flies or fly fishing more than twenty-five trout  
6 in one day in said pond; it shall also be unlawful for any  
7 person to take, catch and carry away more than fifteen  
8 pounds of trout in one day taken from said pond.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this  
2 act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than ten nor more

3 than thirty dollars and costs for each offense and a further  
4 penalty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or  
5 had in possession in violation hereof.

Sect. 3. Provided, further, that this act shall not take  
2 effect until the Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and Game,  
3 without expense to the State, have caused notices to be  
4 posted in conspicuous places at or near the waters herein  
5 described setting forth in substance the provisions of this act.
