## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in East Carry Pond in the County of Somerset.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in ` Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. It shall be unlawful for any person to take, 2 catch or kill with bait and nook more than twenty-five trout 3 in one day in East Carry pond, in the county of Somerset; 4 it shall also be unlawful for any person to take, catch or kill 5 with artificial flies or fly fishing more than twenty-five trout 6 in one day in said pond; it shall also be unlawful for any 7 person to take, catch and carry away more than fifteen 8 pounds of trout in one day taken from said pond.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this 2 act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than ten nor more

3 than thirty dollars and costs for each offense and a further4 penalty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or5 had in possession in violation hereof.

Sect. 3. Provided, further, that this act shall not take
2 effect until the Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and Game,
3 without expense to the State, have caused notices to be
4 posted in conspicuous places at or near the waters herein
5 described setting forth in substance the provisions of this act.
