STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Swan Lake and its tributaries, in
the towns of Searsport, Swanville and Frankfort, in the
County of Waldo.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or kill any kind
2 of fish except smelts on or through the ice in Swan lake,
3 situated in the towns of Swanville, Frankfort and Searsport,
4 in the county of Waldo, or to take, catch or kill at any time
5 any trout less than ten inches in length, or any salmon less
6 than fourteen inches in length taken from said Swan lake,
7 or from any of its tributaries, under the same penalty as is
8 provided in the general law of the State for illegal fishing.
