IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to permit ice fishing for pickerel only in North Pond,
situated in the towns of Buckfield and Sumner, in the County
of Oxford.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

So much of section 1 of chapter 407 of the private and
2 special laws of 1903 as prohibits ice fishing for pickerel in
3 North pond, in the towns of Buckfield and Sumner, in the
4 county of Oxford, is hereby repealed.
