STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to prohibit the throwing of mill waste into the tributaries to Lake Webb, also to regulate fishing in Lake Webb and Webb's river, in the county of Franklin.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall put, or allow the same to be
2 done by any person within his employ, into any of the tribu-
3 taries of Lake Webb, in the county of Franklin, any mill
4 waste, slabs, edgings, sawdust, or any other mill waste of
5 a fibrous nature created in the manufacture of any sawn or
6 planed lumber, or shall place or deposit the same on the
7 banks of any of these waters in such negligent or careless
8 manner that the same shall fall or be washed into any of said
9 waters, or with the intent that the same shall fall or be
10 washed into any of said waters.

Whoever shall violate any of the provisions of this section
12 shall be subject to a penalty of not less than fifty dollars nor
13 more than one hundred dollars and costs of prosecution for
14 each offense.

Sect. 2. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take or catch
2 any kind of fish at any time in Lake Webb, in the county
3 of Franklin, except in the ordinary method of trolling or
4 casting with artificial flies or fly fishing, from the time the
5 ice goes out in the spring until the first day of June of each
6 year.

Sect. 3. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish at any time in Webb's river, the outlet
3 of said Lake Webb, down as far as Goodwin's Mill Dam on
4 said river.

Sect. 4. Whoever violates any of the provisions of Sec-
2 tions two and three of this act shall be subject to a penalty
3 of not less than ten nor more than thirty dollars for each
4 offense and a further penalty of one dollar for each fish
5 taken, caught, killed or had in possession in violation of the
6 provisions hereof.
