RESOLVE in favor of Margaret Jane Tibbetts of Hermon.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury of the

- 3 Tibbetts of Hermon dependent mother of Horace Tibbetts
- 4 deceased, beginning January first, nineteen hundred and
- 5 seven and to continue during the pleasure of the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Margaret Jane Tibbetts of Hermon had two sons, Horace and Benjamin Tibbetts, one of whom, Horace, is now deceased, leaving this mother without any support whatever, (she having been abandoned by this son Benjamin) except such as has been received through the state pension office of this state. She is now eighty-five years of age and in feeble health absolutely unable in any way to provide for herself.

Horace Tibbetts served in Company L of the First Maine Heavy Artillery.
