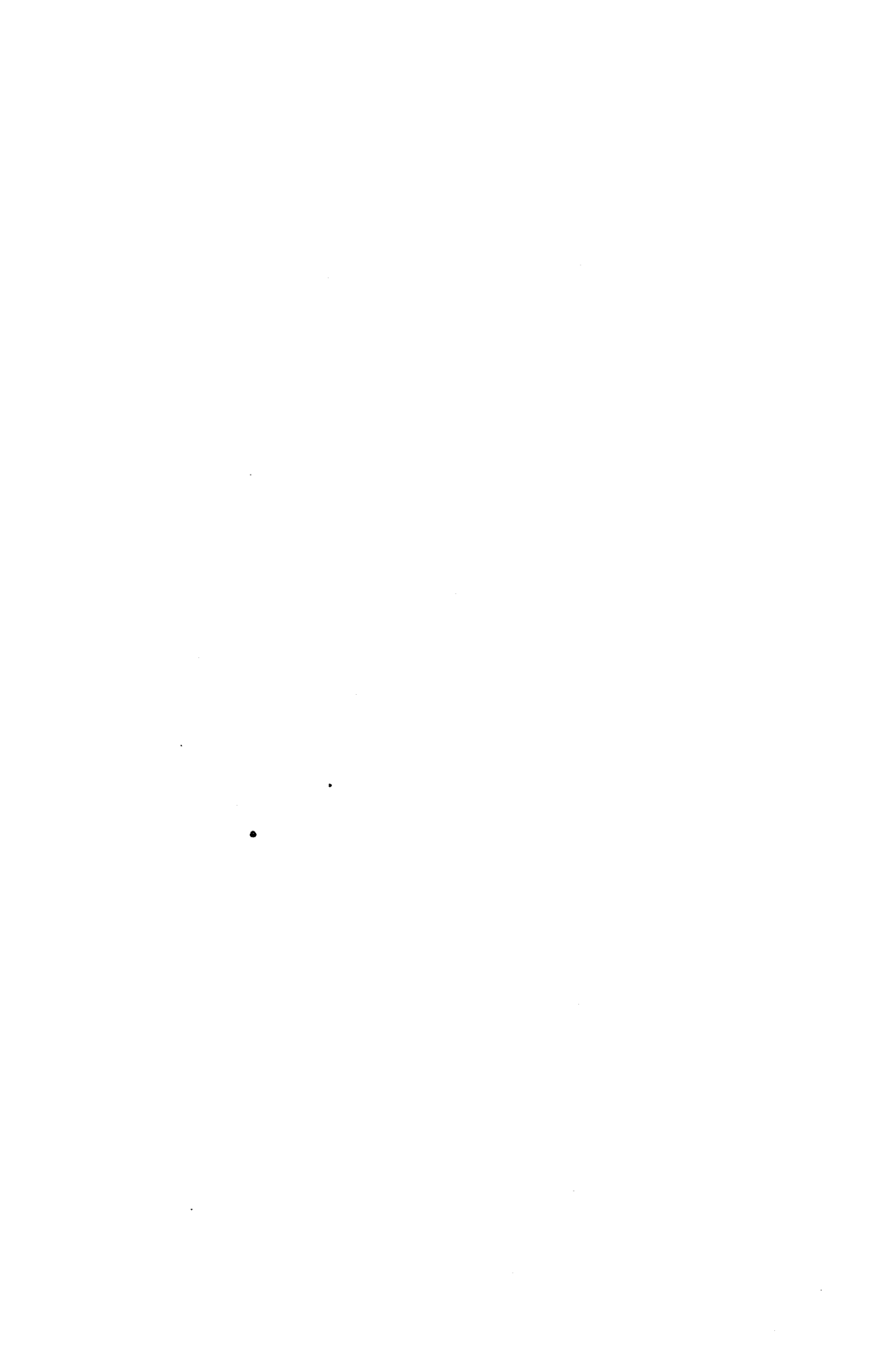
AN ACT to exempt blind persons from the payment of poll tax.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Paragraph VII, section VI of chapter IX of the
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the
3 words 'or blind' so that said paragraph as amended shall read
4 as follows:

'VII. The polls and estates of Indians; and the polls of
6 persons under guardianship or blind.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
