IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to set off the real estate of Mary E. Warren from the
town of Brownfield and annex it to the town of Denmark.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:* ..

Section 1. All the real estate now owned by Mary E.
2 Warren of Brownfield in the county of Oxford and state of
3 Maine, situated in said town of Brownfield, is hereby set off
4 from said town of Brownfield and annexed to the town of
5 Denmark, in said county of Oxford.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
