
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT in relation to compensation for clerk hire in the office of the Clerk of Courts for the county of Androscoggin.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. From and after the first day of January, nine-
- 2 teen hundred and seven there shall be allowed for clerk hire
- 3 in the office of the clerk of courts for the county of Andros-
- 4 coggin the sum of six hundred dollars per annum payable 5 quarterly.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
