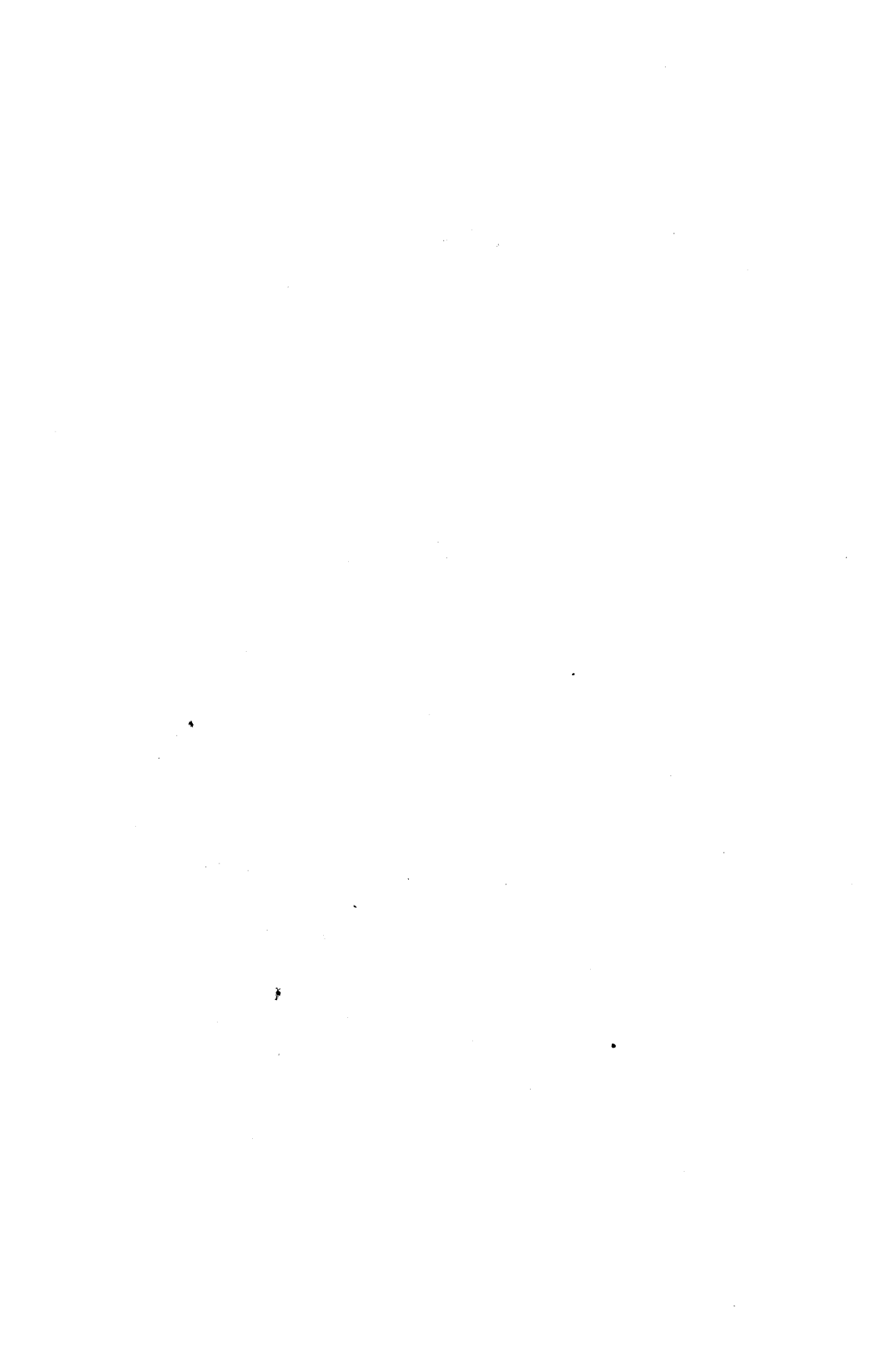
AN ACT to set off a part of the town of Steuben in the county  
of Washington and annex it to the town of Milbridge in said  
county.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. All the land known as the Fred J. Leighton  
2 road, being a strip of land three rods wide and one hundred  
3 and fifteen rods long used as a road by Fred J. Leighton,  
4 said road leading from said Leighton's residence to the Mil-  
5 bridge town road known as the Marsh road.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
