IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to set off a part of the town of Steuben in the county of Washington and annex it to the town of Milbridge in said county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. All the land known as the Fred J. Leighton

- 2 road, being a strip of land three rods wide and one hundred
- 3 and fifteen rods long used as a road by Fred J. Leighton,
- 4 said road leading from said Leighton's residence to the Mil-
- 5 bridge town road known as the Marsh road.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
