## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, making appropriations for the Passamaquoddy

Tribe of Indians.

Resolved: That the sum of two thousand, three hundred 2 and fifteen dollars be appropriated from the funds belonging 3 to the Indians now in the treasury obtained from the sale of 4 land and timber stumpage on the Indian township, held in 5 trust by the State for said Indians, for the year nineteen hundered and seven, as follows:

For obtaining a supply of pure water at Pleasant Point, one 8 thousand dollars; for obtaining pure water at Peter Dana's 9 Point, two hundred fifty dollars; for repair of schoolhouse 10 at Peter Dana's Point, three hundred dollars; for repair of 11 chapel at Peter Dana's Point, five hundred fifty dollars; for 12 finishing bathroom and adding second coat of paint to Sis-13 ters' House at Peter Dana's Point, one hundred thirty dol-

14 lars; for finishing second story of vestry at Peter Dana's 15 Point, eighty-five dollars. Said amount to be expended 16 under the direction of the Governor and Council.
