STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, making appropriations for the Passamaquoddy
Tribe of Indians.

Resolved: That there be paid from the state treasury, to
2 be expended under the direction of the governor and council,
3 to the agent of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians for the
4 benefit of said tribe for the years nineteen hundred and seven
5 and nineteen hundred and eight, as follows:

For May dividends each year four hundred dollars; for
7 November dividends each year, four hundred dollars; for
8 distressed poor each year, four thousand dollars; for agri-
9 cultural purposes each year, six hundred dollars; for plowing
10 each year one hundred fifty dollars; for fertilizer each year,
11 one hundred fifty dollars; for bounty on crops each year, one
12 hundred fifty dollars; for wood each year, six hundred fifty

13 dollars; for educational purposes each year, twelve hundred
14 dollars; for salary of priests each year, four hundred dollars;
15 for salary of goernors each year, one hundred dollars; for
16 salary of lieutenant governors each year, forty dollars; for
17 salary of agent each year, four hundred dollars; for salary
18 of police at Pl. Point each year, one hundred dollars; for
19 basket ash each year, three hundred fifty dollars; for school
20 books each year, sixty dollars; for fuel for schools and church
21 at Pleasant Point each year, one hundred twenty-five dollars;
22 for insurance on churches and houses each year, eighty dol-
23 lars; for repairs of road, Peter Dana's Point each year, one
24 hundred dollars; for repairs of road, Pleasant Point, 1907
25 only, one hundred dollars; for contingent purposes each year,
26 two hundred dollars.

Amount for nineteen hundred and seven, nine thousand
27 seven hundred fifty-five dollars; for nineteen hundred and
28 eight, nine thousand six hundred fifty-five dollars.
