STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of the Western State Normal School
at Gorham.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of three thousand two hundred and fifty dollars for the
3 year 1907 and three thousand two hundred and fifty dollars
4 for the year 1908 for the Western State Normal School at
5 Gorham, the same to be expended by and under the direction
6 of the trustees of the normal schools for the State.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The appropriation for which the accompanying resolve is presented is for the relaying of floors in five rooms, for exterior and interior painting of the school building, for laying the floor and completing room on the third floor of addition, so that the same may be used, and putting heat in same, for addition to the reference library of the school, for bookcases and furniture in the new rooms, for sundry repairs for the years 1907 and 1908, and for grading the grounds.
