STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVES providing for a State Auditor.

Resolved, Two-thirds of both branches of the Legislature 2 concurring, that the constitution of this state be amended, 3 as follows: There shall be a state auditor who shall be 4 elected biennially on the second Monday in September by 5 the electors having the qualifications prescribed by section 6 one of Article II of the Constitution of Maine as amended 7 and whose duties and compensation shall be prescribed, 8 determined, and fixed from time to time, by the Legislature.

Resolved, That the aldermen of cities, selectmen of towns 10 and assessors of plantations, in the state are hereby empow11 ered and directed to notify the inhabitants of their respective
12 cities, towns and plantations, in the manner prescribed by
13 law, at the annual meeting in September, nineteen hundred

14 and eight, to give in their votes upon the amendment pro-15 posed in the foregoing resolve; and the question shall be 16 "Shall the constitution be so amended so as to provide for 17 a state auditor, as proposed in said resolve?" and the inhab-18 itants of said cities, towns and plantations, shall vote by 19 ballot on said question; those in favor of said amendment 20 voting "Yes," and those opposed voting "No," upon their 21 ballots; and the ballots shall be received, sorted, counted, 22 and declared, in open ward, town and plantation meeting, 23 and fair lists of the vote shall be made out by the aldermen 24 of cities, selectmen of towns and assessors of plantations, 25 and signed by them, and attested by the clerk, and returned 26 to the office of secretary of state, in the same manner as 27 votes for representatives; and the governor and council shall 28 open and examine, and count the same, and make return 29 thereof to the next Legislature, and if it shall appear that 30 a majority of the votes cast and returned on the question 31 is in favor of said amendment, the constitution shall be 32 amended accordingly; and the amendment shall then be a 33 part of the constitution, and the governor shall make known 34 the fact by his proclamation.

Resolved, That the secretary of state shall prepare and 36 furnish to the several cities, towns and plantations, blank 37 returns in conformity with the foregoing resolve, accom-38 panied by a copy thereof.
