IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Orono Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Orono

- 2 Trust Company, which were granted by chapter two hun-
- 3 dred eighty of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen
- 4 hundred five, are hereby extended for two years from the
- 5 approval of this act, and the persons named in said act, their
- 6 associates and successors, shall have all the rights, powers
- 7 and privileges that were granted them by said act, to be
- 8 exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as
- 9 specified in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
